CARIBBEAN CANADIAN ASSOCIATION OF WATERLOO REGION SCHOLARSHIP INFORMATION

The Caribbean Canadian Association of Waterloo Region “CCAWR” Scholarship is awarded to Caribbean-Canadian students residing in the Waterloo region wishing to attend College/ University or a Post Secondary Institution in Canada in order to promote academic excellence, foster Leadership skills and encourage community involvement among our youth.

- **ELIGIBILITY:**
 1. Must be a Canadian citizen or a permanent resident of Canada.
 2. Age 17 to 25 years of age as of the end of September of the year the scholarship is granted.
 3. May be either a currently enrolled full time college student or a graduating high school student. The applicant must be studying or accepted for study towards a diploma, degree or certificate in any field at any accredited College, university or Post Secondary Institution.
 4. If a graduating high school student the applicant must have graduated or be scheduled to graduate from an accredited high school (public or private) prior to submitting an application.
 5. A Scholarship may be granted to an individual who may not have exceptional academic achievements but has demonstrated outstanding talent in some other field for example the Arts or Industrial discipline.

- **SELECTION CRITERIA:**
 1. Outstanding academic achievement or recognized talent in any other discipline.
 2. Exceptional community service.
 3. Exemplary leadership qualities.

- **APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS:**
 1. A completed application form must be submitted by the deadline date along with a Passport– size photograph of the applicant.
 2. The names and contact information of two (2) references as outlined in the Application form. One may be a teacher from your school, college or university. The other must be from an individual (other than your teacher or family member) who is familiar with you and can attest to your community service.
 3. Proof of acceptance or confirmation of enrollment from the institution you plan to attend.
 4. Up to date official transcript from the institution you are currently attending/or last attended.
 5. A one-page essay explaining why the scholarship should be awarded to you.
